- Completion of Quality Control documents
- Report all incidents, near misses and equipment damage to site supervision
- Assist with other duties as required

The candidates will need to have the following qualifications:

- Journeyperson with 5+ years Painting (Zinc, Epoxy, Polyurethanes) & Blasting experience
- Previous experience in the use and maintenance of paint spray systems including conventional, airless, and plural
- Ability to read and understand drawings and specifications
- Perform work in a safe manner in accordance with safe work practices, policies, and procedures
- Ability to identify hazards
- Ability to communicate via radio;
- Must be capable of working in an Arctic environment;
- Fit tested and capable of working while wearing full or half face respirators;
